



Dear Parents/Carers

LEWIS' CHEST IS BRACED

On Friday 12th July 2019 at The Spire St Anthony's Private Hospital in Cheam South London at 2pm Lewis attended a Very Special Appointment at The Pectus Clinic. He met not only his consultant Mr Ian Hunt (Harley Street Specialist) but also Joe Porcello from Pectus Services who is the manufacturer and designer of the T-Joe Chest Brace (The Best Chest Bracing System throughout the United States and Internationally). Both the consultants explained to Lewis what was going to happen and then applied an anaesthetic cream to his chest and started to use a massage technique to manipulate his sternum back into place. It was incredible to watch as Lewis was very nervous but kept very calm throughout the manipulation process, as both consultants put him completely at ease.

After the manipulation was complete, 'LEWIS' CHEST WAS CORRECTED' both Mr Ian Hunt and Joe Porcello started to prepare his chest brace. Lewis conducted himself amazingly well and we are extremely proud of our son. The chest brace which has been specifically designed uniquely for Lewis was applied and put in place. It has a front and back plate using a ratchet system. Lewis has a day and night time setting by which he has a 'wearing schedule' to follow and will be required to wear the brace for 8 - 12 months to correct which once was Pectus Carinatum!

BUT - of course NONE OF THIS WOULD HAVE BEEN MADE POSSIBLE, WITHOUT THE OVERWHELMING RESPONSE LEWIS HAS RECIEVED TO 'HIS STORY!!

Back in April when we first discussed launching Lewis' Gofundme Campaign we never could have imagined that we would be able to make this life changing treatment possible for our son. 
We are looking to appoint a friendly and enthusiastic person to join our Breakfast and After School Club team. The successful candidate will:
