

Thank you so much for your support. Our clients are very grateful. We have again seen much increased levels of need this year. Our warehouse stocks are not as low as at this time last year. However, last winter saw unprecedented levels of need and we gave out more food than we had ever distributed.

We urgently need:

- Instant Mash (Drum or Packet)
- 1lt Long Life Fruit Juice
- Tinned Spaghetti
- Sponge Puddings
- Sugar (500g packs please if possible)

Needed to maintain stocks:

- Pasta Sauce
- Tinned Cold Meats—Ham, Corned Beef, Spam
- Tinned Fruit
- Long Life Milk
- Tea Bags (40s or 80s)
- Tinned Tomatoes
- Tinned Rice Pudding
- Deodorant
- Washing Power/Liquid

Due to the generosity of our community, at present we do not need: Toothpaste, Tinned Hot Meat, Baked Beans, Tinned Potatoes, Packs of Pasta.

* Please note: We often ask for small packs—Larger packs do not fit in our boxes and make it difficult for out clients to carry home. Also, we are unable (for hygiene reasons) to split large size or catering packs.

PLEASE NOTE: We are grateful for your donations to the Braintree Area foodbank. However, we can only accept donations of freshly-bought, unopened and undamaged goods which are still well within their "use by" date (no less than 6 months where possible). It is difficult to use items which do not meet these requirements. Thank you.

Any sessions booked and agreed on an ad hoc basis are payable up front and there is no refund if these sessions are then cancelled or changed.

For regular bookings (i.e. the same sessions each week) the terms and condition require one month's notice of any changes or cancellation and you will be charged during the notice period.

Please note that at present Little Fingers has reached capacity and therefore any new requests for a regular place will be added to our waiting list.

Visit https://www.essex.gov.uk/free-school-meals to check whether you may be eligible for free school meals and apply for children in Year 3 and above. If you wish to apply and your child is in Foundation Stage or Key Stage 1 please obtain a form from the school office.

For children who are on the free school meals register the school is entitled to receive additional funding known as Pupil Premium. This additional funding is used to support these children particularly and others that are not making the expected progress, as well as purchasing additional equipment and resources.
