Dear Parents/Carers,

Since September 2014, all children in Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to receive a free school meal, if they wish.

However, for low-income families schools are entitled to receive additional funding £1,320 per child (known as Pupil Premium). We use this additional funding to support these children particularly and others that are not making the expected progress, as well as purchasing additional equipment and resources.

- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act, 1999
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit, with a household income of £7,400 or less (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
