

Meet Father Paschal, who is living in the presbytery next to the school and serving the local Catholic churches.


We hope he will be able to lead some services and are looking forward to seeing him around school.

...and the Year 1 children have made the great transition from FS and are settling well.








Meanwhile the new FS children are enjoying standing taller on their stilts...




