No phone system

Our current phone system has failed, and we are waiting for a new system to be installed. As a result, we have a change to how you can contact the school in the interim.



All child illness related absences need to be emailed to the admin email address (admin@bishops.essex.sch.uk), stating the name of the child, their class and the reason for the absence. A follow up call will be made to you, if required.

We will have a temporary mobile number which is the Little Fingers phone. The number is 07716 391704, *please only use this number to contact the school if there is an emergency*. Please note that this number, or a withheld number, will be used to call out from school should we need to communicate with you.

All early pickups and changes to collection of children will need to be sent **via email** to the admin email <u>by 12.45pm at the latest</u>, to minimise disruption to lessons. Any unavoidable emergency messages after this time should be by phone no later than 2.30pm.


