Thank you to Griffin for joining me on the trombone to play the last post, and to so many of you who were able to join us.






Year 6 have represented the

The primary school (Reception) admission round opened on **Monday 6th November 2023** for parents of children to apply for a Reception school place for the academic year that starts in September 2024.

The statutory national closing date for applications is 15th January 2024.

From 6th November 2023, applications should be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

All of the application information is available on the website above, as well as a copy of the Primary Education in Essex 2024/25 booklet and the Schools Admissions Policies Directories.

Even if a parent already has their child's sibling at the school, they need to apply if they have a child due to start Reception next September. Thank you.


