They both train at the school every Tuesday evening from 6.30pm to 7.30pm with the Wakarishin Jujitsu club.






A big well done also goes to Sascha who won the 'piano age 9-10 category' in the Chelmsford

The primary school (Reception) admission round opened on **Monday 6th November 2023** for parents of children to apply for a Reception school place for the academic year that starts in September 2024.

The statutory national closing date for applications is **15**th **January 2024**. **From 6**th **November 2023**, applications should be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

All of the application information is available on the website above, as well as a copy of the Primary Education in Essex 2024/25 booklet and the Schools Admissions Policies Directories.

Even if a parent already has their child's sibling at the school, they need to apply if they have a child due to start Reception next September. Thank you.


