Here's what Rehan had to say about his experience yesterday morning...


"In 6A we made a healthy meal for our design and technology project. We had two halves of pita bread and multiple toppings.

## R.E & School Ethos



This week, we had R.E and School Ethos monitoring carried out by staff, governors and an external lead RE teacher from one of our RC family of schools.

We interviewed children from across the school, looked at their RE work, and let them talk to us about their experience of assemblies, worship, RE, the school motto and all things Bishops' 'spirit'.

The pupils we spoke to seemed to really enjoy RE, loved the opportunity to learn about other faiths, and to be wrapped up in the difficult dilemmas of faith (the Year 5s and 6s especially tackle the faith/ science questions of creation/ evolution or of whether love can ever be 'conditional'). Whenever we do monitoring like this we are amazed at the depth of your children's thinking, how much they think about the wonder of life — and their respect for others.

#### Here are just a few quotes:

For the question – **Do you sometimes feel close to God?:** 

'I love singing.' 'I like reading our own Bibles.' (Yr 2)

'When I'm on my own – I look up and think about God...'(Yr 3)

'Prayers help - you feel relaxed' (Yr 3)



'It feels like God is with us, and supports us when times are hard..' (Yr 4)

'When we pray in school I can pray to my own God' (from a Hindu pupil) – (Yr5)

'Church definitely helps me especially when I am having a hard day. It helps me to be ready for

learning. I am into the worship – I try and pray in the worship and feel God is encouraging me...' (Yr 6)

#### Do you feel special in school?

'The adults remind us that we are all special...' 'We learn together...' 'People care about me and we learn from our mistakes...' (Yr 3)

'It's the love and care..' (Yr4)



'(I feel special because) we can be ourselves and be different..' (Yr 5)

'This is a kind school – it honours who you are...' (Yr 6)

### Anything else? – especially related to our school motto...


'God made a world for us, He looks after us, He loves us.' (Yr 2)

## Uniform and P.E Kit

Please remember that children should **always** be in school uniform UNLESS a sports club allows them to wear alternative clothing better suited to the sport being undertaken (currently running and football).

In other sports clubs, children should be wearing school uniform PE kit. If children come to school wearing non-school uniform for a sports club, then they should get changed before class starts into school uniform (including school PE kit if it's a PE afternoon). I hope that is clear!

The only logo on school uniform should be the school logo – whilst other clothing is allowed so long as it is the right colour etc., it should not be 'logo-ed' – this includes trainers (which should be black).


