### Club List and Letters

Please find attached details of clubs that will be running this term. Most clubs will start week commencing **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024** (unless otherwise advised) and finish on week ending **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024** (unless otherwise advised).

We do not wish to prohibit children from being able to partake in any of our clubs and therefore, if meeting the cost of a club (including clubs run by outside providers) is likely to create difficulties for you then please contact the school office as soon as possible as there are a limited number of Pupil Premium places available per club.

Most clubs have a maximum number of children that they can accommodate and therefore, places will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis, but we will try to ensure that every child who wishes is able to take part in at least one club. If you'd like to add your child's name to a waiting list, then please email Miss Foale at [c.foale@bishops.essex.sch.uk](mailto:c.foale@bishops.essex.sch.uk) and they will have priority booking if the same club runs next term.

**Clubs led by outside providers have their own fees and details of these, along with how to make payment, will be enclosed on separate pages within this booklet. Please be aware that some clubs led by outside providers have different start and end dates.**

If your child is attending a before or after school club then their arrival and collection point will usually be at the blue chicken gate. We please ask that children arrive promptly for clubs, as late arrivals can cause disruption. Almost all the children behave well during club time, and it is important that club time is not disrupted. If children misbehave they are likely to be told to miss the club the following week and we will notify you. There will not be a refund.

If you wish to book your child/ren into a club, please pay and give consent online via Scopay or according to the provider's instructions.

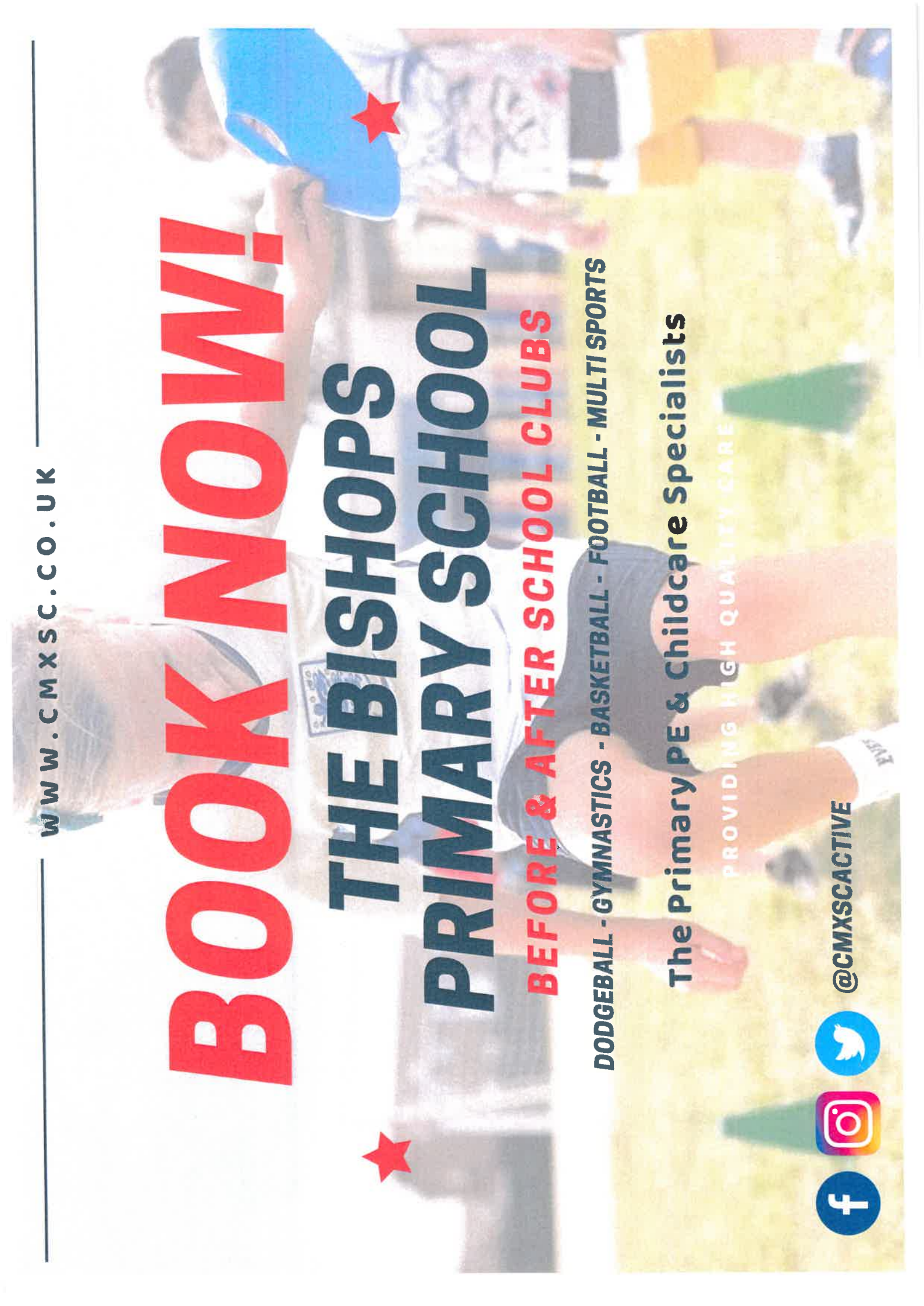

### After School Club School Mini Tennis

## Location: Bishops' Primary School

Hi, I'm Piers Nightingale, Head Coach of the Junior Section at Hamptons Sports & Leisure. As a LTA Licensed Coach, LTA Senior Club Coach Level 4 and RPT European Pro, I am running and developing the Hamptons S&L junior coaching programme. The first stage of our club programme is the after school tennis club sessions that are running in a number of local primary schools. The Hamptons S&L School Link is an initiative set up to give children the chance to experience the sport with clear development paths through into the coaching programme that runs at Hamptons S&L.

The idea is to start children playing tennis at school indoors with short racquets and soft balls. Within lessons we aid and develop children's racket and ball skills, hand-eye co-ordination, balance, movement and stroke techniques and most of all have lots of FUN.

This course is the first stage of a progressive coaching programme run by Hamptons, which takes children from mini tennis to full court tennis.

**This course will run at your School for 10 sessions on Mondays at 15:15. The dates for this term are: January 15<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, February 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, March 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>.
