

Boswells Primary PE Academy - Wednesdays 4.00 - 5.00 - Striking & Fielding, and Athletics

We are delighted to invite your son/daughter to the next instalment of the Boswells Primary PE Academy. Y3 & 4 SUMMER SPORTS CAMP - Wednesday 24th July - Friday 26th July 2024

We are pleased to invite you to the first edition of The Boswells School Year 3 & 4 Summer Sports Camp!

Having run a successful summer sports camp for Year 5 & 6 students for nearly 20 years now, we are delighted to be able to extend our provision by offering Year 3 & 4 students access to opportunities in a variety of sports across a developmental and, most importantly, fun-filled week of activities. The sports on offer will include football & futsal, netball, volleyball, basketball and water polo, amongst others.

The Year 3 & 4 Summer Sports Camp will run from Wednesday 24th July to Friday 26th July 2024, from 9.00am 2.00pm each day. Activities will take place in The Boswells School sports hall, gym, netball courts, playing fields and swimming pool. Your child will be taught by Boswells' PE staff as they learn new techniques and skills in various sports, and how to transfer those skills into game situations. The workshop is for pupils who learn an orchestral instrument in or out of school and who have passed Grade 1to Grade 5. This year there will be just one session for everyone so that all players can enjoy the full orchestral sound created by the mix of beginner, intermediate and Grade 4/5 parts.
