

Dear Parents/Carers and Children,

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The secondary school admission round opened on Thursday 12th September 2024 for the parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school Year 7 place for their child for September 2025.

Applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions - parents of Year 6 children need to log onto the website and make an application by the statutory national closing date of 31st October 2024.

Harvest




We are celebrating and giving thanks for all things harvest on Tuesday 15th October – and this year our gifts will be going to the local Pop-Up Food Bus which serves our area.




Poppy

Club Spaces


As you will know, many clubs are full and we have priority lists for these for next term BUT we still have places in some of our outside provider-led clubs – it's not too late to get in and start.




Since it launched last week, our ASDA Cashpot has steadily grown to over £80 and we have 78 days left to until it closes!
