Christmas production ticket Sales seem to be causing some disquiet, which is never our intention. Your children are beginning to rehearse for them, the stage is up, Advent displays are being made for the hall, and the songs of Christmas are beginning to echo through the corridors! Here's a message from Mrs Boreham which I hope will make things as clear as possible regarding the tickets:

We would like to clarify the situation about the Christmas Performances as we are aware that there have been discussions amongst WhatsApp groups.

Firstly, we would like to say that if you have any queries or concerns regarding something that is happening within school then please always communicate with us directly. WhatsApp groups should be for sharing only useful information with other parents/carers.

Prior to COVID, Christmas Performance tickets were sold via Scopay and this year we are reverting back to this system. We have made this change to try to improve efficiency for all, around collecting money, distribution of audience spaces, as well as being aware that people are not carrying as much cash now. However, the £2 has remained the same since before COVID. If families cannot afford this then we encourage them to contact the school office <u>in confidence</u>.

Please note that no physical tickets will be issued and there are no further donations expected on the door at the performances.

The income from the tickets funds our music and performance licences as well as required props. Any remaining money will contribute towards PTFA-funded projects throughout the school that benefit all of the children.

The ticket allocation for the year group performances vary depending on how many year groups are performing as we have to meet strict fire safety limits.

For information, the year 6 concert service will vary as they will be collecting money to donate to a charity like they did last year as there are no costs involved for this concert.


