toilet visits and supervised the slightly terrifying journeys to and from the coach.

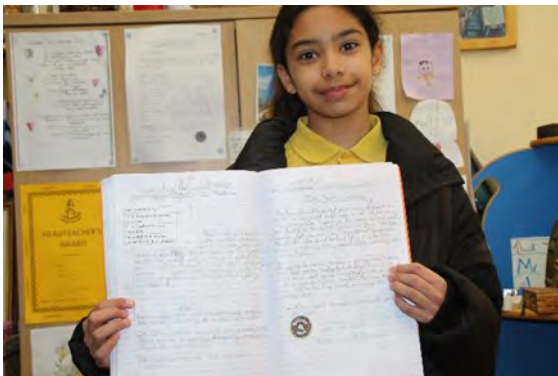
It was great to see so many parents and family members supporting us and enjoying the concert far below! The children were amazing, so well behaved and helpful throughout the day. Thanks to them, too!

Well done Felix for making Cambodian homes which are designed for river-life.



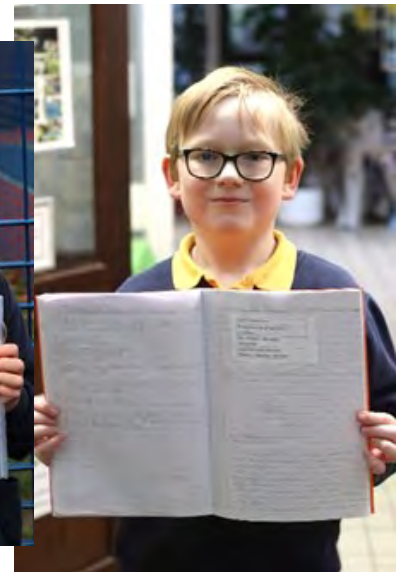
Year 3 have created some amazing bird projects, all uniquely different!

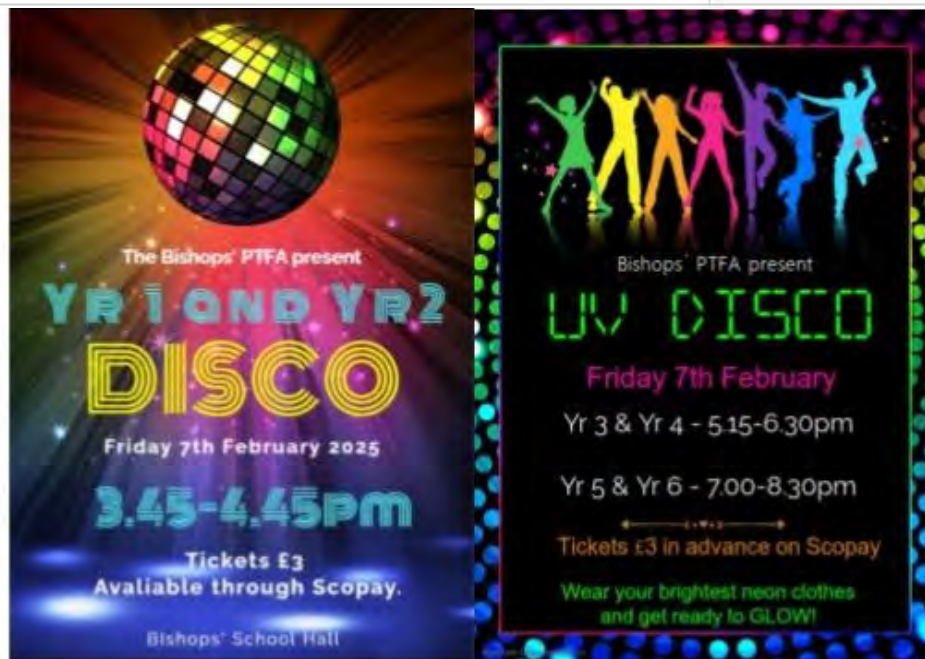


