
YOUNG CARERS AT PIZZA EXPRESS

Eleanora has participated in Charlie and the Chocolate factory, and now she


is doing Peter Pan in July at Chelmsford Theatre, after receiving a Distinction in her Ballet exam, Grade 3.


Nellie has wonderfully raised over £1500 for the Little Princess Trust, through


